Delegates discussed the draft bylaws as they pertained to: meeting noticing, standards of conduct, fiscal year, insurance requirements, and committees.

Additionally, feedback will be made publically available as part of the bylaw committee agenda and AI may be used to provide written summaries of the feedback from the special meetings. Delegates voted to keep the Bylaw Committee with its current members.

Delegate qualifications as they relate to public office were discussed at the meeting. No motions were voted on.

2026 Leadership & Officer Summit

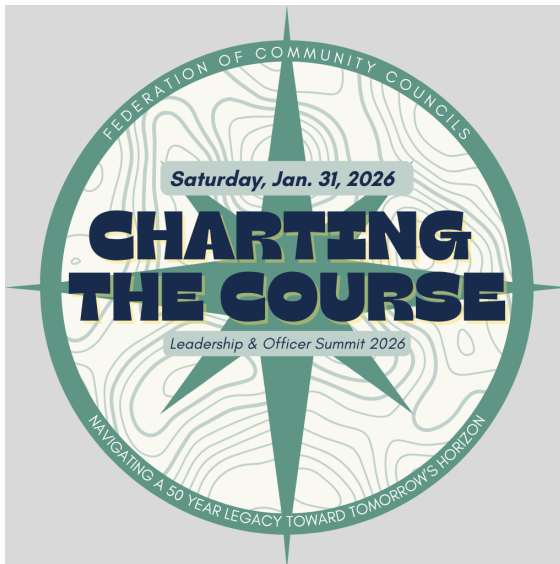
Saturday, January 31, 2026 @ The Nave
